


Consistently higher rates of depression, all ages








Suicide Rates for Males in US, by age group

Suicide risk by age (2019-2021)

- Utah population
 - 20.6 per 100,000
- 65-74
 - 26.6 per 100,000
- 75+
 - 47.8 per 100,000

Suicide Risk among Older Adults

- Fastest growing segment of the population
- Significant gender disparity
- Lethal means access
 - More likely to use firearms
 - Increased access to medications
- Cognitive impairment
- Chronic pain
- Older adults are more likely to die following an attempt
 - Frailty
 - Isolation
 - Planned

Mental Health Care - Best Practices

- Evidence-based psychotherapy
- MH medication management
- Hearing/vision
- Connectedness
 - Social network
 - Community
- Regular physical activity
- Sense of purpose and meaning

Crises among Older Adults


- Suicide/homicide ideation
- Medical issues that present as mental health
- Psychosis
- "Failure to thrive"
