CAAs in Utah

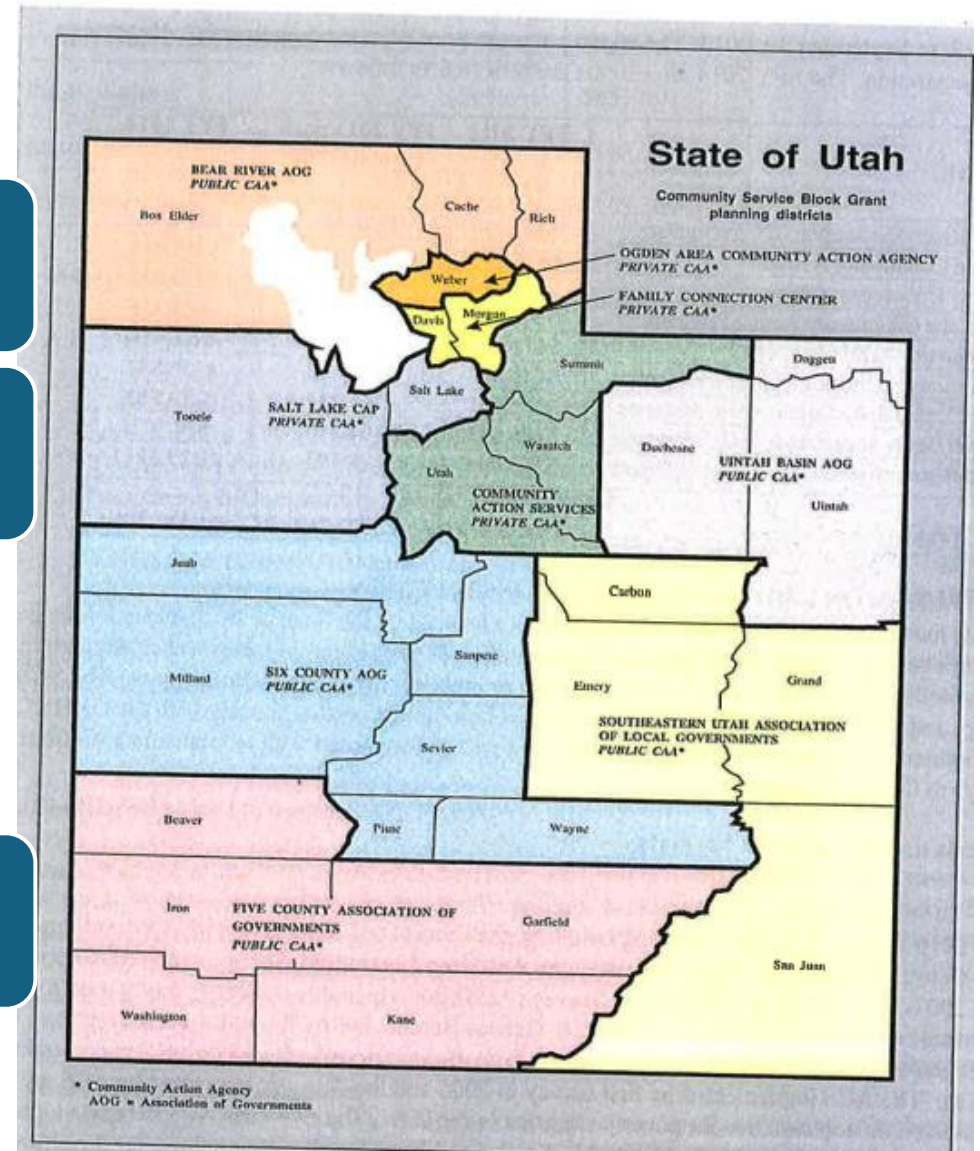
Utah's 9 CAAs cover all 29 counties and serve over 96,000 low-income Utahns.

- Digital Equity Planning Grant

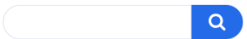


Digital Access Plan – A Roadmap to the Future

- Plan was submitted to Nation Telecommunications and Infrastructure Administration (NTIA) in March 2024 and accepted in April 2024
- The plan is a living document and a roadmap to creating “ a Utah where all are invited to fully participate in modern society through access to affordable high-speed internet, safe and reliable devices, and training to achieve digital independence. “

Utah's Digital Equity Plan Accepted

APRIL 11, 2024

WASHINGTON – The Department of Commerce's National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA) has accepted Utah's Digital Equity plan.

The Digital Equity Act, part of the Internet for All initiative and a key piece of President Biden's Investing in America Agenda, provides \$2.75 billion to establish three grant programs that promote digital equity and inclusion. The program aims to ensure that all people and communities have the skills, technology, and capacity needed to reap the full benefits of our digital economy.

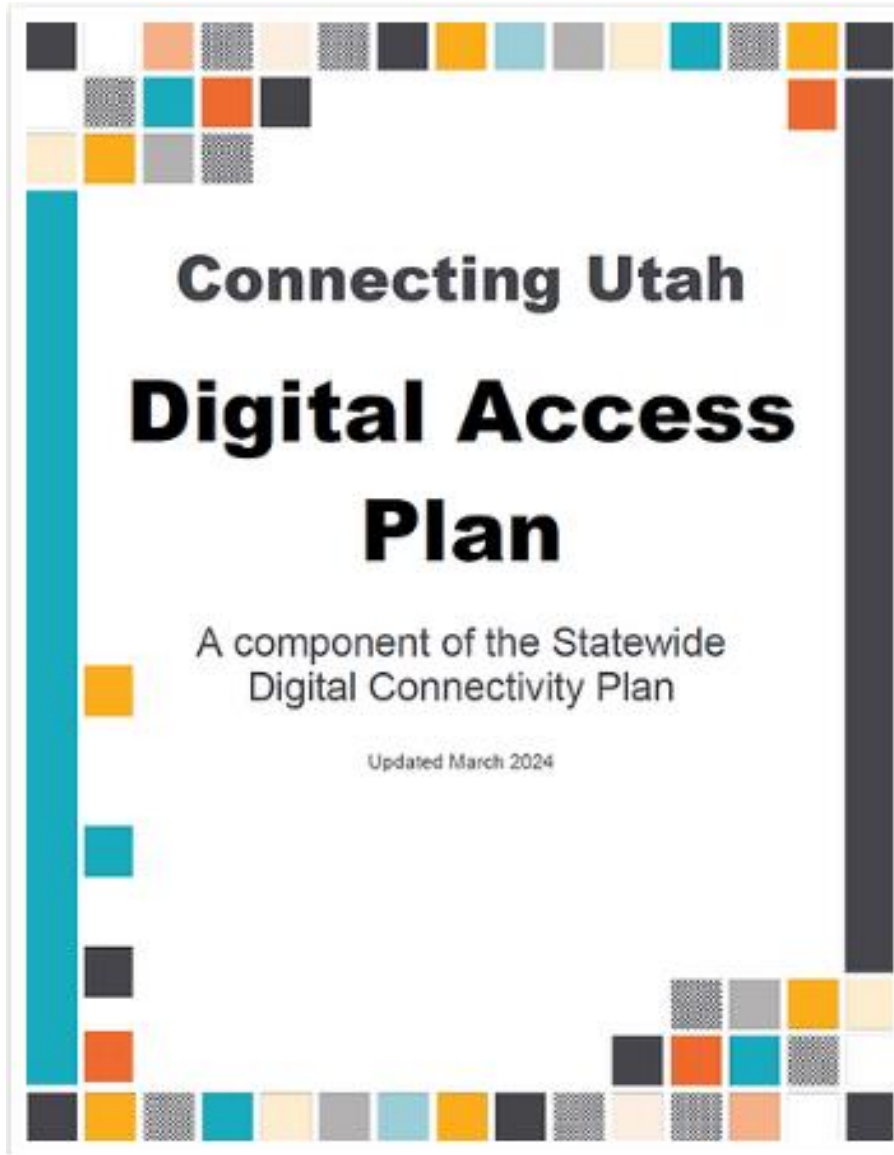

GOALS

- Goal of the plan is to train for digital independence and economic mobility
- Connect every Utahn affordability, accessibility, and safety
- Increase the availability of dependable devices
- Build a coordinated, sustainable community (Utah Digital Opportunity Network – UDON)

State digital equity plan

KEY STRATEGIES

- . Promote programs that build digital skills and support local initiatives
- . Partner thoughtfully to put connectivity within reach for every resident



State digital equity plan

KEY STRATEGIES

- . Invest in changes at the system level that impact device access**
- . Think collaboratively and share generously among digital inclusion practitioners**

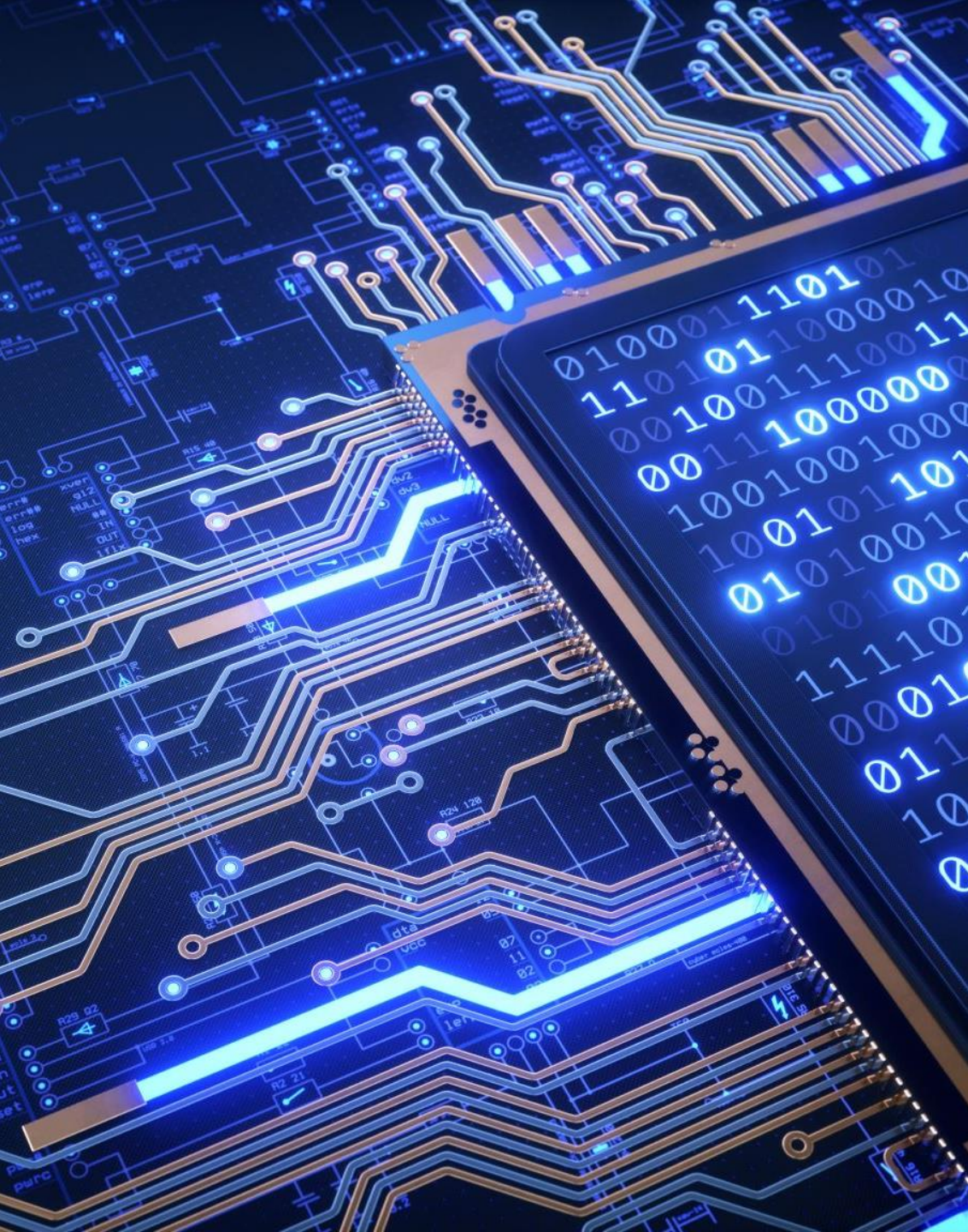
Working together to close Utah's digital divide.

What is Digital Navigation?

- **Navigators - Trusted guides** who assist community members in the use of computing devices, internet adoption, and device procurement. Also called Mentors, Digital Navigators, or variations of Tech Help.

CAP Utah Working with UDON on Statewide Digital Equity Grant

Support

CAP Utah will support statewide digital navigator effort – specifically bring in CAAs that serve rural and frontier communities

Work

CAP Utah will work to build a network of meeting families where they are at – food pantries, utility assistance, tax preparation sites, etc. – and connect them to community hubs for trainings and additional resources

Act

CAP Utah will act as a lead for other partners who specialize in other covered populations identified through the Utah Digital Opportunity Network

- CAP Utah will create “linkages” between CAAs and other grant partners

Support

CAP Utah will support Tech Charity as a strategic partner in increasing refurbished devices in rural Utah

Bring

CAP Utah will bring its network to UDON while working with a Regional Community Action collaboration of Mountain and Plain States.

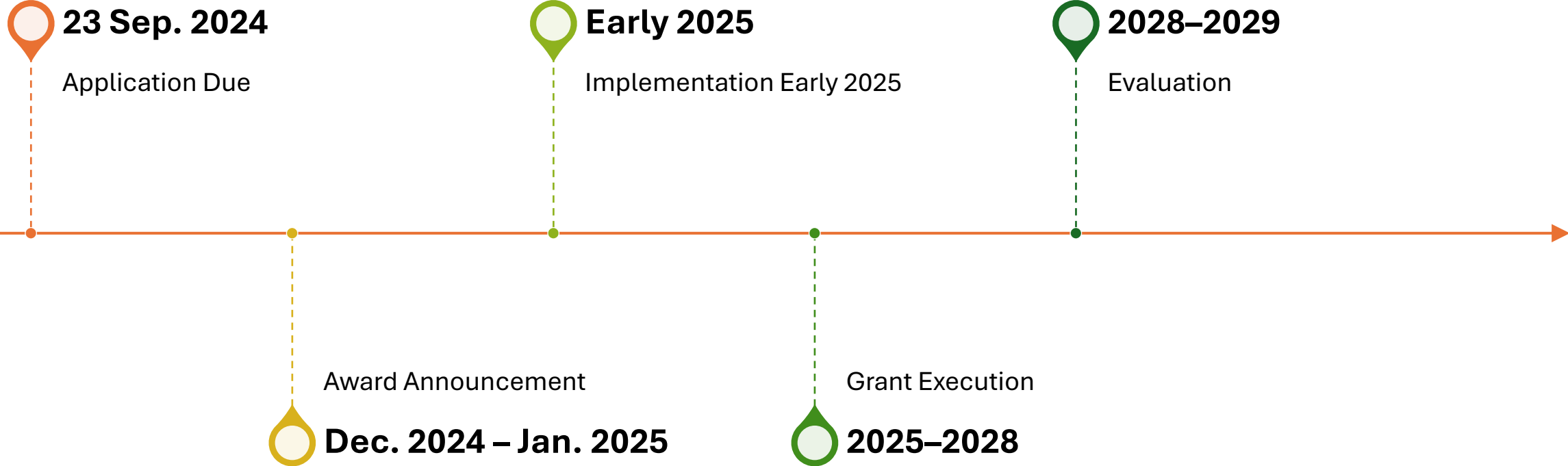
